A Reflection of the Father

Do you remember that famous line in Genesis (1:27): “In His image he created them”? This means that we are a direct reflection of the face of Christ. We receive Him even more closely in the sacraments of Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation. Jesus gave us a direct path to holiness through the sacraments and the moral guidance of the Church. If we follow this path we can be so closely united to Him that others can't help but notice the presence of the Lord in us.

In the Gospel today Jesus says to Thomas “No one comes to the Father except through me. If you know me, then you will also know my Father.” Then later He says to Philip, “Whoever has seen me has seen the Father.”

I like to put myself into this Gospel by reminding myself that when people see me, they see the Father because Jesus is in me. I carry His image within my own. What a responsibility! By people knowing me, they should also know the Father through me.

Most of the reasons I've heard of why people have left the faith have to do with the ugliness they've seen in some people who claim to carry Christ in them. This makes me reflect on how I live everyday life. When I walk through the grocery store, do I show people kindness? When I'm in a conversation, do I listen with compassion?

Every encounter we have, we should remember that our role is to help others see the Father, and grow in relationship with Him.



SAINTS PHILIP AND JAMES, APOSTLES

May 3

Call Philip the gospel's “Answer Man.” “Can anything good come out of Nazareth?” Nathaniel asked Philip, who had proclaimed Jesus “the one about whom Moses wrote in the law, and also the prophets” (John 1:45). Jesus asked Philip, “Where can we buy enough food for them to eat?” (John 6:5). Greeks brought Philip their request: “We would like to see Jesus” (John 12:21). Philip's answer to each question: bring people to Jesus! At the Last Supper, finally, Philip had a request of his own: “Show us the Father!” (John 14:8). Jesus had three last questions for Philip: “You still don't know me? How can you ask that? Don't you believe?” And an answer: “I am in the Father and the Father is in me” (John 14:10). Today's James is not John's brother, Zebedee's son, but, tradition says, author of the New Testament Letter of James, who died praying for his murderers in Jesus' words: “Forgive them, for they know not what they do.” Few historical details for either saint, but lessons aplenty: Bring every question we have and everybody we meet to Jesus; be, as James' letter challenges, “doers of the word and not hearers only” (James 1:22).
